#### HEREFORD AND WORCESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Hereford and Worcester (High Street, Feckenham) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1992*

Notice is hereby given that Hereford and Worcester County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time on the sides of lengths of High Street in the Parish of Feckenham in the Borough of Redditch in the County of Hereford and Worcester, specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions in the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading and/or unloading goods;
- (c) delivering and collecting mail by Post Office vehicles;
- (d) delivering and collecting furniture and effects with police consent;
- (e) any building or demolition operation, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the supply and maintenance of any gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus;
- (f) the fire brigade, ambulance or police services;
- (g) the pursuance of statutory powers or duties (if no other road can be conveniently used).

An exemption in the Order also permits the waiting by disabled person's vehicles displaying a badge issued under the Local Authority's Orange Badge Scheme for a limited period of three hours, return prohibited within a further period of one hour. Full details of these proposals are contained in the draft Order which together with a map showing the sides of lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined from Monday to Friday during normal office hours at:

- (1) County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester.
- (2) Redditch Borough Council Offices, Town Hall, Alcester Street, Redditch.

Objections to the proposal, giving reasons, must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 10th December 1992.

#### HEREFORD AND WORCESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Hereford and Worcester (Various Roads, Cropthorne, Charlton and Fladbury) (Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles of Over 7.5 Tonnes) Order 1992.*

Notice is hereby given that on 5th November 1992, Hereford and Worcester County Council made an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(4) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be that no person shall cause or permit any heavy commercial vehicle the maximum gross weight to which exceeds 7.5 tonnes to proceed in the lengths of roads in the parishes of Cropthorne, Charlton and Fladbury, in the district of Wychavon, in the county of Hereford and Worcester, specified in the First Schedule to this notice in the directions indicated.

Exemptions are contained in the Order for vehicles of the following classes or for the following purposes in the lengths of road specified in the First and/or Second Schedule to this notice if the vehicle:

- (a) is being used for or in connection with the conveyance of persons, goods, merchandise, furniture or effects;
- (b) is being used in any building or demolition operation, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the supply and maintenance of any gas electricity, water and telecommunication apparatus;
- (c) is being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (d) is being used for the purpose of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to the lengths of roads specified in the Second Schedule or in the conveyance of timber felled upon that land;
- (e) is being used to gain access for the services of a garage;
- (f) is being used in connection with a circus, fair or similar event which has been authorised by the Council;
- (g) is being used for or in connection with the conveyance of goods for sale from that vehicle;
- (h) is being used to gain access to any land or premises where there is not a satisfactory alternative means of vehicular access;
- (i) is a mechanical road cleansing vehicle;
- (j) is being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
