The plan became operative on 4th November 1992, but if any person aggrieved by the plan desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by Part II of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, or that any requirement of the said Part II or of any regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the adoption of the plan, he may, within 6 weeks from 14th November 1992, make an application to the High Court under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 116

Diversion of Part of Bridleway 23 at South Newsham, Blyth

Notice is hereby given that Blyth Valley Borough Council, as agent of Northumberland County Council, the highway authority, will make an application to the Magistrates' Court sitting at Blyth on Monday, 14th December 1992, at 10 a.m., for an Order that the following part of Bridleway 23, at South Newsham in the Borough of Blyth Valley shall be extinguished and diverted on the ground that such diversion will be nearer or more commodious to the public:

To extinguish that part of Bridleway 23 running from the rear of 24 Epsom Way, South Beach, Blyth at O.S. Ref. 30787939 and leading in a north-easterly direction for approximately 57 metres and then in a north-westerly direction for approximately 233 metres to a ditch at O.S. ref. 30637961 and to divert the said way between the said points at O.S. ref. 30787939 and O.S. ref. 30637961.

A plan showing the proposed extinguishment and diversion has been deposited at the Civic Centre, Blyth and at the Council Offices, Seaton Delaval and may be inspected there free of charge during normal office hours.

Any person to whom notice has been given or any person who uses the said highway or any person who may be aggrieved by the making of the Order shall have a right to be heard at the hearing of the said application.
