The Wealden District Council (Off-street Parking Places) (Amendment) Order 1992

Notice is hereby given that on 11th November 1992 the Wealden District Council made an Order under section 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) to control the use of the parking place at Church Marks Lane, East Hoathly. The Order amends and revises Paragraph 10 of the Schedule and the map annexed to the Wealden District Council (Off-street Parking Places) Order 1990 (as amended by the Wealden District Council (Off-street Parking Places) (Amendment) Order 1991) by substituting an amended and revised Paragraph No. 10 in the Schedule to the Order and an amended and revised map annexed to the Order.

The effect of the amendments and revisions to the Schedule and map to the 1990 Order (as amended) can be summarised as follows:

- (a) the description "Church Marks Lane Car Park" in the Schedule is amended to read "Church Marks Lane Parking Place".
- (b) the map annexed to the Order now includes a strip of land approximately 86 metres long on the south-eastern side of Church Marks Lane within the land referred to as the Church Marks Lane Parking Place.
- (c) Paragraph 10 of the Schedule to the Order relating to Church Marks Lane Parking Place makes provision for and restricts the use of a loading and unloading bay adjacent to the Village Hall.

The Order comes into operation on 18th November 1992.

A copy of the Order, together with maps showing the location of the parking places and the statements of reasons for making the Order, may be seen at the Wealden District Council offices at Pine Grove, Crowborough and Vicarage Lane, Hailsham between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Thursdays and between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Fridays.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application to the High Court for that purpose.
