## WIRRAL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

Metropolitan Borough of Wirral Traffic Regulation Orders

Notice is hereby given that Wirral Borough Council in exercise of its powers have made the following Orders under sections 1, 2, 4, 35, 36, 37 and 39 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

- A. Residential Parking Places (Burns Avenue, Daresbury Road, Monk Road, Newell Road, Glyn Road and Barnwell Avenue) Order 1992. The effect will be to:
  - (a) designate the roads described in Schedule A to this notice as parking places with permits;
  - (b) prohibit vehicles from parking in those places unless they display a valid permit issued by the Council for that purpose.
- B. Residential Parking Places (Longview Avenue, Seaview Avenue, Fairview Avenue, Merton Road and Silverlea Avenue) 1992.
- (a) The effect will be to designate the roads described in Schedule B to this notice as parking places with permits;
  - (b) prohibit vehicles from parking in those places unless they display a valid permit issued by the Council for that purpose.
- C. Victoria Road, Birkenhead.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at the times, lengths and sides of the roads specified in Schedule C to this notice

Exceptions will be provided in the Orders to permit picking up and setting down of passengers, loading and unloading of goods, maintenance of roads, supply of gas, electricity and water, in pursuance of statutory powers and duties, disabled person's parking and hackney carriages to wait upon authorised ranks.

The Orders will come into operation on 18th November 1992, and copies thereof may be seen at all reasonable hours at the Borough Solicitor and Secretary's Department, Town Hall, Wallasey.

If you wish to question the validity of the Orders of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act of 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Orders you may within 6 weeks of the date of this notice apply to the High Court for this purpose.
