3. Any meat or offal imported under this licence shall be made available if so required for inspection by an officer of the Ministry at any place nominated by him for such inspection. The importer or his agent shall afford all assistance necessary to such an officer to enable him to carry out the inspection in such manner as he shall determine and the importer shall be responsible for meeting any costs of carrying out such an inspection.

4. The health certificate specified in Clause 1 must be presented to Her Majesty's Customs and Excise at the Port of Entry.

Directive 88/657/EEC on trade in minced meat, meat in pieces of less than 100 grams and meat preparations signed by an official veterinarian of the Government of the exporting country in accordance with any European Commission Decision in force at the time of certification stating:

I, the undersigned official veterinarian, hereby certify that the minced meat, meat in pieces of less than 100 grams, meat preparations described above were obtained under the conditions of production and inspection in accordance with Directive 88/657/EEC laying down the requirements for the production of, and trade in, minced meat, meat in pieces of less than 100 grams and meat preparations and amending Directives 64/433/EEC, 71/118/EEC and 72/462/EEC.
