The County of Powys (Market Square and Clock Tower Square Hay-on-Wye) (Disabled Persons' Parking Spaces) Order 19

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Powys proposes to make an Order under sections 32(1) and 35(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The purpose of the Order is to designate the areas of Market Square and Clock Tower Square, Hay-on-Wye, specified in the Schedule to this notice as parking spaces for disabled persons' vehicles only, subject to the restrictions contained in the said Schedule.

The waiting restrictions which currently apply to the proposed parking spaces will be revoked, except that in Market Square the special provision for market traders on market days will continue to apply.

Details of these proposals are contained in the draft Order which, together with (i) a plan showing the location of the above parking spaces and (ii) a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined during office hours at the Powys County Hall, Llandrindod Wells and the Post Office, Hay-on-Wye.
