*North Bedfordshire Borough Council (Various Roads, Bedford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Consolidation Order 1992, Amendment No. 3/1992.*

*Royal County of Berkshire (Kendrick Road, Reading) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1992*

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of the Royal County of Berkshire propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to—

1. prohibit waiting at any time on:
  - (a) *Kendrick Road, Reading, east side:*
    - (i) between its junction with London Road and a point 63 metres south of that junction.
    - (ii) between a point 123 metres north of its junction with Morgan Road and a point 112 metres north of that point.
    - (iii) between a point 17 metres south of its junction with Morgan Road and a point 38 metres north of that junction.
    - (iv) between a point 38 metres south of its junction with Allcroft Road and a point 33 metres north of that junction.
    - (v) between its junction with Christchurch Road and a point 34 metres north of that junction.
  - Kendrick Road, Reading, west side:*
    - (i) between its junction with London Road and a point 83 metres south of that junction.
    - (ii) between a point 249 metres north of its junction with Christchurch Road and a point 56 metres north of that point.
    - (iii) between a point 123 metres north of its junction with Christchurch Road and a point 59 metres north of that point.
    - (iv) between its junction with Christchurch Road and a point 30 metres north of that junction.
  - (b) *Allcroft Road, Reading, north side,* between its junction with Kendrick Road and a point 16 metres east of that junction.  
*Allcroft Road, Reading, south side* between its junction with Kendrick Road and a point 26 metres east of that junction.

2. prohibit waiting Mondays to Saturdays (inclusive) 8 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. on:

##### *Kendrick Road, Reading, east side:*

- (i) between a point 34 metres north of its junction with Christchurch Road and a point 38 metres south of its junction with Allcroft Road.
- (ii) between a point 235 metres north of its junction with Morgan Road and a point 101 metres north of that point.

##### *Kendrick Road, Reading, west side:*

- (i) between a point 182 metres north of its junction with Christchurch Road and a point 67 metres of that point.
- (ii) between a point 305 metres north of its junction with Christchurch Road and a point 190 metres north of that point.
- (iii) between a point 83 metres south of its junction with London Road and a point 48 metres south of that point.

There are waiting restrictions in existence on these roads which will be removed by the revocation of the Borough of Reading (Kendrick Road Area) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1991.
