ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The Trunk Road (A5) (Betws-Y-Coed, Gwynedd) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1992

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made on Order under sections 1, 2, 4 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will come into operation on 18th January 1993.

The proposal was advertised on 1st August 1991. Following the receipt of objections to the original proposals, modifications have been made to the Order. The effect of the Order as modified is to impose (with the usual exemptions) an all year round waiting prohibition along the sides of the trunk road described in Schedule 1 to this notice and a seasonal prohibition from 15th March to 30th September along the sides of the trunk road described in Schedule 2 to this notice. This Order revokes the provisions of the Trunk Road (A5) (Betws-y-Coed, Gwynedd) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1983.

A copy of the Order, a copy of the Order being revoked, together with a plan may be inspected at Betws-y-Coed Post Office, Holyhead Road, Betws-y-Coed, from 9 a.m. to 5.30 p.m. Monday to Friday, and from 9 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. Saturday.

Copies of the Order may be obtained, free of charge, on application to the Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Phase 1, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL, quoting ref. ZC 510-2-4-46.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order, or of any provisions contained therein on the grounds:

(a) that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984; or

(b) that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any of the requirements of that Act,

he may, within 6 weeks of the 26th November 1992, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order, or of any provision contained therein.

SCHEDULES

Sides of the London-Holyhead Trunk Road (A5) at Betws-y-Coed in the County of Gwynedd

SCHEDULES 1

1. the northern side of the trunk road which extends from a point 268 metres west of its junction with the B5106 to a point 55 metres south of the southern end of the railway bridge.
2. the southern side of the trunk road which extends from a point 166 metres west of its junction with the B5106 to a point 142 metres south of that junction.
3. the western side of the trunk road which extends from a point 116 metres south of its junction with the road leading to St Michael's Church to a point 55 metres south of the southern end of the railway bridge.

SCHEDULE 6

1. the southern side of the trunk road which extends from a point 142 metres south-east of its junction with the B5106 to a point 378 metres south-east of that junction.
2. the northern side of the trunk road which extends from a point 268 metres west of its junction with the B5106 to a point 440 metres west of that junction. (481)

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981, SECTION 29

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment acting under section 29 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, made the Sawston Hall Meadows (Cambridgeshire) Nature Conservation Order 1992 applying section 29(3) of the Act to the lands described in Schedule 1 to the Order which appear to the Secretary of State likely to destroy or damage the fen meadow and calcareous grassland habitat and associated flora and fauna by reason of which the site is of special interest and of national importance.
