### GATESHEAD METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

#### *The Borough Council of Gateshead (Rothbury Gardens/Cragside Gardens, Lobley Hill) (Waiting Restrictions) Order 1992*

Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Gateshead propose to make an Order under sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to introduce:

#### (a) No waiting at any time on:

- (i) West side of Rothbury Gardens, Lobley Hill from its junction with Lobley Hill Road southwards to a point 47 metres north of its junction with Cragside Gardens.
- (ii) West side from a point 12 metres south of its junction with Cragside Gardens to a point 15 metres north of that junction.
- (iii) East side of Rothbury Gardens, Lobley Hill, from a point 12 metres south of its junction with Cragside Gardens to its junction with Lobley Hill Road.
- (iv) Both sides of Cragside Gardens from its junction with Rothbury Gardens westwards for 10 metres.

#### (b) Limited waiting 30 minutes between 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday:

West side of Rothbury Gardens from a point 15 metres north of its junction with Cragside Gardens northwards for 32 metres.

Normal exemptions would apply including those for disabled persons' vehicles.

Full details of this proposal are contained in the draft Order which, together with a map and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the offices of the Director of Legal and Administrative Services, Civic Centre, Regent Street, Gateshead, Monday to Thursday between 8.45 a.m. and 5 p.m., and Friday between 8.45 a.m. and 4.35 p.m. (ref. HW12/610). If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should

### MID GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

#### *The Mid Glamorgan County Council (Pengam Road, Ystrad Mynach) (Variation) and (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1992*

Notice is hereby given that on 23rd November 1992 the Mid Glamorgan County Council made an Order under sections 1, 2, and 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to:

1. Vary the provisions of the Urban District Council of Gelligaer (Various Streets, Ystrad Mynach) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order (No. 1) 1970, by the deletion from Schedule 2 of that Order of the restriction along the southern side of Pengam Road, Ystrad Mynach, from its junction with Bedwlwyn Road, south-eastwards for a distance of approximately 33 yards.
2. Prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on the sides of lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exemptions are provided in the Order to enable Medical Practitioners and Veterinary Surgeons to visit while "on call" and for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading and unloading, building and roadworks, the maintenance, improvement, reconstruction, inspection or survey of the sides of lengths of road, the maintenance of essential services, weddings, funerals and the delivery or collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office. Disabled persons' vehicles displaying the relevant disabled person's badge are allowed to wait for up to 3 hours with return prohibited within 1 hour.

The Order came into operation on 26th November 1992 and a copy thereof and a map showing the sides of lengths of road to which the Order relates may be inspected at the offices of the Mid Glamorgan County Council, Cathays Park, Cardiff, during normal office hours until the end of 6 weeks from 26th November 1992.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks from 26th November 1992, apply to High Court for this purpose.

### MID GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

#### *Mid Glamorgan County Council (Chapel Street, Bridgend) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1992*
