*The Borough of Dudley (Faulkner Close and Hill Street)
Stourbridge (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1992*

Notice is hereby given that the Dudley Metropolitan Borough Council propose to make the above Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time in the following lengths of Faulkner Close and Hill Street, Stourbridge:—

Faulkner Close, west side for its entire length.

Hill Street, north side from Faulkner Close to a point 90 metres west.

Exemptions will permit waiting for as long as it is reasonably necessary for the following purposes:

- (a) Picking-up and setting down of passengers,
- (b) Loading or unloading goods,
- (c) Building industrial or demolition operations,
- (d) Work in connection with the maintenance of the road and adjacent land and the provision of water, gas, electricity and telecommunication services,
- (e) The delivery or collection of postal packets.
- (f) The activities of the fire, ambulance and police services,
- (g) In connection with weddings and funerals.

A copy of the draft Order and the plan together with the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at the Council House, Dudley during normal office hours.

Any objections or representations with respect to the Order should be submitted to me in writing stating the grounds upon which they are made and should be received by me no later than 18th December 1992.

*The Borough of Dudley (Birmingham Street/ Stourbridge Road and
Associated Street, Stambermill, Lye) (Prohibition of Waiting)
Order 1992.*

Notice is hereby given that the Dudley Metropolitan Borough Council propose to make the above Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any item in the following lengths of road:

Bagley Street, both sides, between Birmingham Street and Yardley Street.

Birmingham Street, both sides, from Stourbridge Road to a point 75 metres south of Hungary Hill.

Grayling Road, both sides, from Bagley Street to a point 15 metres north-west.

Hungary Hill, both sides, from Birmingham Street to Ridge Grove.

Stourbridge Road, both sides, from Birmingham Street to a point 5 metres east of Hickman Street.

Exemptions will permit waiting for as long as it is reasonable necessary for the following purposes:

- (a) Picking up and setting down passengers.
- (b) Loading or unloading goods.
- (c) Building, industrial or demolition operations.

(d) Work in connection with the maintenance of the road and adjacent land and the provision of water, gas, electricity and telecommunications services.

(e) The delivery or collection of postal packets.

(f) The activities of the fire, ambulance and police services.

(g) In connection with weddings and funerals.

The Order will also contain an exemption permitting disabled persons' vehicles to park for periods not exceeding three hours with return within one hour prohibited.

DURHAM COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Durham (Unclassified Lowland Road, Brandon)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1992*

Notice is hereby given that the Durham County Council have made an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which is as set out in the Schedule to this notice.

The Order which comes into operation on 30th November 1992, contains exemptions in respect of boarding or alighting; loading or unloading of goods; building operations and demolitions; removal of obstruction to traffic; maintenance of the road; Post Office vehicles, fire brigade, police or ambulance vehicles; statutory powers and disabled persons.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks from 26th November 1992 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

No Waiting At Any Time

On the west side of Carr Avenue from a point 5 metres north of its junction with Lowland Road, southwards for a distance of 30 metres.

On both sides of Lowland Road from its junction with Carr Avenue, in a westerly direction for a distance of 15 metres.

No Waiting 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

On the north side of Lowland Road from a point 15 metres west of its junction with Carr Avenue, westwards to its junction with Lowland House access road.

On the south side of Lowland Road from a point 15 metres west of the junction with Carr Avenue, westwards to a point opposite the boundary between Nos. 8 and 9 Lowland Road.

On both sides of the service road adjacent to Nos. 4 to 8 Lowland Road, inclusive.
