The County Council of West Sussex (Billingshurst: Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and One-Way Traffic) (and Consolidation) Order 1992.

Notice is hereby given that on 25th November 1992, West Sussex County Council made a permanent Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), the effect of which will be to:

- (i) extend the existing prohibition of waiting at any time on both sides of West Street (A272), Billingshurst; and
- (ii) prohibit waiting from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. from Mondays to Fridays inclusive on a length of the north side of Brookers Road.

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of West Sussex (Clayton and Keymer: Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (and Consolidation) Order 1992.

Notice is hereby given that West Sussex County Council propose to make a permanent Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to:

- (i) revoke a length of the existing prohibition of waiting at any time in the new lay-by on the east side of London Road (A273), Clayton;
- (ii) prohibit waiting at any time on lengths of both sides of Clayton Avenue, Keymer, and on the west wide of Downs View Road at the junction of these roads;
- (iii) extend the existing waiting restriction on the east side of Downs View Road and revoke a length of waiting restriction on the west side;
- (iv) extend the existing prohibition of waiting at any time on the east side of Lodge Lane;
- (v) limit waiting to one hour in any two hours between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. from Mondays to Saturdays on a length of the south side of Orion Parade. It is also proposed to prohibit waiting at any time on a short length of the south side of Orion Parade at the eastern end; and

- (vi) prohibit waiting at any time on short lengths of both sides of Stanford Avenue and on a short length of London Road (A273), Clayton at the junction of these roads.
