*Tunbridge Wells Borough Council (Buckingham Road, Grecian Road, Norfolk Road, Arundel Road and Claremont Road (Part) (On-street Parking Place) Order 1992.*

Notice is hereby given that the Tunbridge Wells Borough Council in exercise of its powers under sections 36, 39 and 45(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation (Parking) Act 1986, has made an Order which will come into operation on 7th December 1992, the effect of which will be:

1. To designate those lengths of roads set out in the Schedule below as on-street car parks on a permanent basis;
2. To introduce a charge of £20 per annum for concessionary parking permits issued to residents owning a vehicle and residing in one of the above roads;
3. To exclude those vehicles not displaying a valid permit from parking in the said roads between the hours of 10 a.m. to 11 a.m. and 3 p.m. to 4 p.m., Monday to Friday.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the date of this notice, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
