Notice of Designation of Conservation Area Changes to the Maryport Conservation Area

Notice is hereby given that under section 69 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990, Allerdale Borough Council have resolved to amend the Conservation Area in Maryport as follows:

Deletion of the Harbour Area: In the west of the town, comprising land and properties at the harbour from the mean high water mark in the far west to the western banks of the estuary of the River Ellen in the east, and from North Pier in the far north southwards, but excluding south quay which remains within the Conservation Area.

Deletion of the King Street/Nelson Street Area: In the north-west of the town comprising land and properties from the mean high water mark in the far west to the foot of the embankment in the east, and from a line to the rear of these properties fronting onto North Quay in the far south northwards.

Deletion of the Rugby Ground at Netherhall: In the north-east of the town, comprising land and buildings at Netherhall Rugby Football Ground from the A595 in the west and the boundary with Netherhall school to the north to the south-eastern boundary of the pitch.

Addition of the Area around the Roman Fort: In the far north of the town, comprising of land to the north, north-west and north-east of the site of the Roman Fort from Senhouse Roman Museum in the west to North Grove House in the east, and land to the south-west of the Roman Fort comprising the field to the south.

Effect of these Changes: When the local planning authority exercises its power under the Planning Acts with a conservation area it will:

(a) have regard to the character of the conservation area when exercising these powers.

(b) publicise any proposals affecting the character of the area.

In particular:

(a) no building or structure (except certain small categories) can be demolished without the consent of the local planning authority.

- (b) there are stricter controls over the size of certain extensions to dwellings, and buildings or other enclosures constructed within their curtilage, together with stricter controls over external cladding to a dwelling.
- (c) the powers of the local planning authority to carry out emergency repairs to an unoccupied listed building is extended to include selected unoccupied unlisted buildings.

(d) there are provisions for preservation of trees and the stricter control of advertisements and the siting of satellite dishes.
