Notice is hereby given in accordance with Schedule 10 of the above Act that an application has been made to the National Rivers Authority by Severn Trent Water Ltd. for consent to discharge up to 605 cubic metres per day (113 cubic metres per day under dry weather conditions) of treated sewage effluent and storm sewage via a reed bed treatment facility for flows in excess of 7 litres per second (605 cubic metres per day) to the River Mease at National Grid Reference SK 2103 1188 from Edingale Water Reclamation Works, School Lane, Edingale.
