The Chester-Bangor Trunk Road (A55) (Rhuallt Hill Improvement) (Bodeugan Lane Diversion) Compulsory Purchase Order 199

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales in exercise of his powers conferred on him by the above-named Acts has prepared a draft Compulsory Purchase Order, entitled as above, which he proposes to make, authorising him to purchase compulsorily the land described in the Schedule thereto for the purpose of:

- (i) the construction and improvement of highways at Waen in the community of Tremeirchion, Cwm and Waen and county of Clwyd in pursuance of the Chester-Bangor Trunk Road (A55) (Rhuallt Hill Improvement Bodeugan Lane Diversion and B5429 Alterations Side Roads) Order 199;
- (ii) use by the Secretary of State in connection with such construction and improvement of highways and the execution of other works mentioned above.

Copies of the draft Compulsory Purchase Order and of the plan referred to therein, together with copies of the published draft of the above-named Side Roads Order, with their accompanying plans have been deposited and may be seen at all reasonable hours from 13th January 1993 to 3rd February 1993 at:

- (i) Clwyd County Council, Shire Hall, Mold, Clwyd;
- (ii) Rhuddlan Borough Council, Municipal Offices, Nant Hall Road, Prestatyn, Clwyd;
- (iii) The Clwyd County Council Branch Library, The Roe, St. Asaph;
- (iv) The Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Government Buildings, Dinerth Road, Colwyn Bay; and at
- (v) The Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Phase 1, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff.

- (a) The land comprised in each item in this Schedule is identified on the plan referred to in the draft Compulsory Purchase Order by means of the number shown in brackets against it in this Schedule.
- (b) References to ownership are references to ownership or reputed ownership at the time of preparation of the draft Compulsory Purchase Order and are stated only for the purpose of identification of the land.

Any objections to the draft Compulsory Purchase Order must be made in writing and addressed to the Secretary of State at the Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Roads Administration Division, Phase I, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL, not later than 3rd February 1993, and should state the grounds of objection and quote the reference ZB750148-312-3.
