Notice is hereby given that on 18th February 1993, Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council adopted the above-named Local Plan as modified by them.

THE NATURAL MINERAL WATER REGULATIONS 1985

Recognition of natural mineral water: Matlock Spring, Water Lane, Cromford, Derbyshire.

Notice is hereby given that in the terms of the Natural Mineral Water Regulations 1985, an application has been made by Matlock Water Spa and Spring Ltd., Victoria House, Matlock Springs, Water Lane, Cromford, Derbyshire DE4 3QH, in respect of a supply of water from Matlock Spring for recognition in terms of the Natural Mineral Water Regulations 1985.

The Matlock Spring source will be developed by means of Source Borehole 007, which is located at Ball Eye Quarry, Cromford, Derbyshire, at National Grid Reference SK 428730 357215.

The Derbyshire Dales District Council as the relevant authority in terms of the said regulations have been supplied with details of the method of abstraction and as to the measures taken to protect the emerging water against pollution and other information with regard to the physical and chemical characteristics, micro-biological analyses and with satisfactory evidence regarding the absence of toxic substances, freedom from pollution and stability of composition and other essential characteristics of the water.

The Derbyshire Dales District Council have assessed the particulars supplied in the application by the Matlock Water Spa and Spring Ltd., in conjunction with recommendations made by the Public Analyst and are satisfied with the information provided that the water from Source Borehole 007, conforms with the standards required by Schedules 1 and 2 of the above regulations and accordingly have therefore granted recognition for the purposes of the said Natural Mineral Water Regulations 1985, on 6th January 1993.
