TREASURY

VALUE ADDED TAX

Treasury Direction dated 3rd March 1993 under section 27(2A) of the Value Added Tax Act 1983 as to the refund to Government Departments of tax charged on the supply of goods and services or on the importation or acquisition of goods received by them otherwise than for the purpose of carrying on activities in the course or furtherance of a business.

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 27(2A) of the Value Added Tax Act 1983 (1983 c.55) as inserted by section 11 of the Finance Act 1984 (1984 c.43), hereby direct as follows:

- This direction shall come into operation on 1st April 1993.
- A government department listed or belonging to a category of departments listed in List 1 of this direction may claim and be paid a refund of the tax charged on the supply of services of the nature included in List 2, or on the supply, importation or acquisition of goods incidental to the supply of those services, if and only if,
 - the supply of those services is not for the purpose of any business carried on by the department; or
 - the supply of those services is not for the purpose of any supply by the department which, by virtue of directions made under section 27(2) and (3) of the Value Added Tax Act 1983, is treated as a supply in the course or furtherance of a business; and
 - the department complies with the requirements of the Commissioners of Customs and Excise both as to the time, form and manner of the claim and also on the keeping, presentation and production of records relating to the supply or importation in question.
- The Treasury Directions dated 6th March 1989, 8th March 1990, 5th March 1991, 19th December 1991 and 10th March 1992, made under section 27(2A) of the Value Added Tax Act 1983, are hereby revoked.
