The Avon County Council (Butt Lane and Gloucester Road, Thornbury, District of Northavon) (Restricted Roads) Order 199

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Avon proposes to make an Order under sections 82(2) and 83)2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the effect of which will be:

- (1) that no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the lengths of road Specified in the Schedule to this notice; and
- (2) to revoke the Gloucestershire County Council (Gloucester Road, Thornbury) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order, 1970 which relates to that length of Glooucester Road which extends from 12 yards north-east of Church Road to 15 yards north-east of Park Road—this length of road is included in item 1 above.
