Notice of application for a licence to abstract water and to vary a licence to abstract water

Take notice that Market Rasen Racecourse Ltd. of Legsby Road, Market Rasen, Lincolnshire, is applying to the National Rivers Authority for a licence to abstract water from River Rase-South Branch at National Grid Reference TF 1268 8839 at Market Rasen Racecourse, Legsby Road, Tealby, West Lindsey, Lincolnshire. The proposal is to abstract water at the following rates: 50 cubic metres per hour, 1,136 cubic metres per day, 18,184 cubic metres per year, between 1st January and 31st March each year. The variation being applied for is the transfer of the existing abstraction point for Licence 4/29/2/5/4 at National Grid Reference TF 1249 8855 to point TF 1268 8839. Both points are on the South Branch of the River Rase within Market Rasen Racecourse. The water will be used for spray irrigation of the racecourse and 9 hole golf course. Water will be stored in reservoirs. This licence is to replace the existing winter licence for 13,638 cubic metres.

A copy of the application and any map, plans and other documents submitted with it may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours at Market Rasen Racecourse Ltd. between 3rd June 1993 and 2 July 1993.
