#### COLCHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL

*Colchester Borough (Various Roads, Colchester) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1993*

Notice is hereby given that Colchester Borough Council, as agents for Essex County Council, have made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which will prohibit waiting at all times on specified sides of the lengths of roads in Schedule 1 to this Notice and revoke the existing restrictions on specified sides of the lengths of roads in Schedule 2 to this Notice. The Order brings into effect the proposals advertised in Notice 778 of the *London Gazette*, date 26th April 1993, Issue No. 53285 and will come into operation on 7th June 1993, with the following modification:

The Order also provides that the Order known as The Colchester Borough (Unnamed Road between Headgate and Chapel Street North) (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading) Order 1991 will henceforth be known as the Colchester Borough (Essex Street, Colchester) (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading) Order 1991 and that the description of the road to which that Order relates shall be amended to read "Essex Street, Colchester on both sides for its entire length".

The Order will not prevent vehicles waiting for the purposes of loading or unloading goods, allowing passengers to board or alight or to enable works to be carried out in the road. Exemptions in the Order also permit the waiting of disabled persons' vehicles in accordance with the Orange Badge Scheme.

A copy of the Order with details of the specified lengths of road, a map showing the lengths of roads to which the Order relates and a copy of the Orders to be revoked may be inspected at the Council's office at Angel Court, High Street, Colchester, between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Mondays to Fridays.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied within relation to the Order may within 6 weeks from 7th June 1993 make application to the High Court for this purpose.

*The Colchester Borough (The Avenue, Wivenhoe) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1993*
