DISEASES OF FISH ACT 1937

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, having reasonable grounds to suspect that certain inland waters and land adjacent to them are infected areas, has made the Diseases of Fish (Designated Areas) (England) (No. 8) Order 1993.

The Order designates the areas for the purpose of section 2 of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937, as amended by the Diseases of Fish Act 1983, and restricts the movement of any live fish without the previous consent in writing of the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food.

The Order came into force on 2nd June 1993.
