ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The Trunk Road (A55) (Bodelwyddan—St. Asaph, Clwyd) (De-Restriction) Order 199

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under sections 82 and 83 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to de-restrict the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Notice. It will also revoke and re-enact the provisions of the Trunk Road (A55) (Bodelwyddan, Clwyd) (De-restriction) Order 1986 which currently de-restricts that length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 of this notice.

A copy of the proposed Order, the Order to be revoked, a relevant plan and statement of reasons for making the Order, may be inspected at St. Asaph Post Office, Chester Street, St. Asaph, Clwyd, from Mondays to Fridays between the hours of 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 5.30 p.m., and on Saturdays between the hours of 9 a.m. to 12.30 p.m.

Objections specifying the grounds on which they are made, and quoting ref. ZC510-6-1-39, must be sent in writing to the Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Roads Administration Division,

Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL, by 1st July 1993. In the preparation of an objection and the statement of grounds of objection, it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.

SCHEDULE 1

Lengths of Road near St. Asaph Business Park

- 1. That length of the main carriageway of the A55 Chester-Bangor Trunk Road, (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road") which extends from a point 385 metres east of the centrepoint of the Engine Hill overbridge, at Bodelwyddan to a point 500 metres east of the centre-point of the bridge which connects the northern and southern roundabouts of the St. Asaph Business Park Interchange, a distance of 1970 metres.
- The entry and exit slip roads of the trunk road at St. Asaph Business Park Interchange which connect the northern and southern roundabouts of that Interchange with the main eastbound and westbound carriageways of the trunk road.
- 3. That length of road extending from a point 34 metres southwest of the centrepoint of the southern roundabout of the St. Asaph Business Park Interchange which connects and includes the northern and southern roundabouts of that interchange.

SCHEDULE 2

That length of the trunk road at Bodelwyddan which extends from a point 180 metres west of the centreline of the Engine Hill Overbridge to a point 385 metres east of the centreline of the said overbridge, a distance of 565 metres. (495)
