HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The Mid Glamorgan County Council, (A4119 Cardiff to Llwynpia Classified Road) (Talbot Green to Ynysmaerdy) (Side Roads) Order 1992.

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has confirmed the above Order which was made by the County Council of Mid Glamorgan under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 and which, as confirmed, authorises the council:

- (a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,
- (b) to stop-up highways,
- (c) to construct new highways,
- (d) to stop-up private means of access to premises, and
- (e) to provide new means of access to premises

all on or in the vicinity of the route of the classified road.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or of any regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks of 11th June 1993, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
