ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The Trunk Road (A5) (Valley, Gwynedd) (Variable Speed Limit) Order 1993

Notic is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to impose a 20 m.p.h. speed limit on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice. The speed limit will operate as and when necessary between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. Mondays to Fridays, and will only be in force when signed. It is considered that this measure will improve the safety of pupils attending Ysgol-y-Fali School.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a copy of the Trunk Road (A5) (Valley, Gwynedd) (Restricted Roads) Order 1983, which must be varied, a relevant plan and the statement of reasons for the making of the Order, may be inspected at the Valley Post Office, Station Road, Valley, Anglesey, between the hours of 9 a.m. to 5.30 p.m. Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays, 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Wednesdays and 9 a.m. to 12 noon on Saturdays.

Objections specifying the grounds on which they are made and quoting ref. ZC 510-6-4-42 must be sent in writing to the Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Roads Administration Division, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL, by 14th July 1993. In the preparation of an objection and the statement of grounds of objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-up of Highways (County of West Sussex) (No. 5) Order 1993", authorising the stopping-up of an area of highway verge at the junction of Richmond Road and Heene Road, Worthing, in the County of West Sussex.
