The Commission shall for the purposes of this reference limit consideration to agreements and practices relating to the charges made or quoted for private medical services by suppliers of such services, whereby those suppliers conduct their affairs as mentioned in section 7(2) of the Act.

In this reference-

"medical services" means the provision of medical or surgical advice or attendance and the performance of surgical operations by medical practitioners within the meaning of:

(a) sub-section (1) of section 128 of the National Health Service Act 1977, or

(b) sub-section (1) of section 108 of the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978, or

(c) article 2(2) of the Health and Personal Social Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1972

who hold or have held appointments as consultants within "the health service" or "health services" as defined in these enactments; and

"private medical services" are medical services supplied other than for or on behalf of

(a) a health service body within the meaning of section 4(2) of the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990, or

(b) any of the persons or bodies mentioned in section 17A(2) of the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978, or

(c) any of the persons or bodies mentioned in article 8(2) of the Health and Personal Social Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1991.

The Commission shall report on this reference within a period of 12 months from the date hereof.

Commissioner. The Order shall also impose certain restrictions on the eligibility of persons to be appointed or elected to be a Commissioner and, subject to qualifications incorporates the Commissioners Clauses Act 1847.
