

## WIRRAL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

*Wirral Metropolitan Borough Council, The Central Area of Birkenhead (Off-street Parking Places) 1989 (Amendment No. 1) Order 1993*

Notice is hereby given that the Wirral Borough Council in exercise of its powers has made the above Order under sections 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and all other enabling powers.

The effect of the Order will be to increase the charges for the pay and display car parks within the Central Area of Birkenhead, as specified in the Schedule to this notice.

The level of excess charge will be increased to £25 with a discount of £10 for payment within 1 week.

The Order will come into operation on 19th July 1993, and copies thereof may be seen at all reasonable hours at the Borough Solicitor and Secretary's Department, Town Hall, Wallasey.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act of 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, you may within 6 weeks of the date of this notice, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
