The Stopping-up of Highways (Croescadarn Road, North Pentwyn, Cardiff, South Glamorgan) Order 1993

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 to authorise the stopping-up of the highway described in the Schedule to this notice to enable the development of residential properties, for which planning permission has been granted, to be carried out.

Copies of the draft Order and the annexed plan may be inspected during normal opening hours (10 a.m. to 1 p.m., 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. Mondays to Thursdays, 10 a.m. to 1 p.m., 2 p.m. to 7 p.m. Fridays and 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., 2 p.m. to 5.30 p.m. Saturdays), at Llanedeyrn Library, Maelfa Shopping Centre, Llanedeyrn, Cardiff.

If any person desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds:

- (a) that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, or
- (b) that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any of the requirements of that Act.

he may within 6 weeks of 20th July 1993, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

The highway to be stopped-up is at North Pentwyn, Cardiff, in the county of South Glamorgan and is that length of Crosecadarn Road, situated between the points marked X and Y on the annexed plan, which extends from its junction with the road which gives access to Llanedeyrn Farm in a general southerly direction for a distance of 99 metres. Notice of the Issue of a Submarine Pipe-Line Works Authorisation

The Secretary of State for Trade and Industry hereby gives notice that he has decided to issue, and in consequence has issued, a works authorisation to be held by Britoil plc and Victoria Oilfield Development (UK) Limited, whose respective addresses are Burnside Road, Farburn Industrial Estate, Dyce, Aberdeen AB2 0PB, and Tradewinds, 190 Vauxhall Bridge Road, London SW1V 1DX, for construction of a 6 inch pipe-line between the semi-submersible drilling vessel 'Ocean Guardian' above well 22/20-6 and the dynamically positioned tanker 'Marie Knutsen'.

Except with the consent of the Secretary of State, the pipe-line shall only be used to convey crude oil.

The pipe-line may be used by the holders and with the holders' agreement, and with the consent of the Secretary of State, by other persons.

Britoil plc has been appointed operator of the pipe-line.
