THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

*The County of West Glamorgan (A4067 Cwm Level to Ynysforgan/A48 Wychtree to Valley Way, Dualling, Swansea Classified Roads) order 1992.*

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has confirmed the above Order which was made by the County Council of West Glamorgan under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980, and which, as confirmed, authorises the Council:

- (a) to stop of highways
- (b) to stop up private means of access to premises
- (c) to construct new highways, and
- (d) to improve highways

Copies of the Order, as confirmed, and of the relevant plans may be inspected, free of charge, at all reasonable hours in the County Secretary's Department, County Hall, Swansea; the Swansea City Council Offices, The Guildhall, Swansea and at the Welsh Office, Legal Group, Cathys Park, Cardiff.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of 2nd August 1993, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

### DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT

TOWN AND COUNTY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping-up of areas of highway and footpath on the Jubilee Estate, Elswick, Newcastle.

If the Order is made, the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in the schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted to Newcastle-upon-Tyne City Council Housing Committee by Newcastle-upon-Tyne City Council, on 16th April 1993 under Ref. GRA/01/0183/93.

The proposed Order will provide that the stopping-up must not be carried out until Newcastle-upon-Tyne City Council Housing Committee has carried out the improvement to existing highways and provided the areas of new highway described in the planning permission and that those highways shall be highways maintainable at the public expense, for which the Newcastle-upon-Tyne City Council shall be the highway authority.

Copies of the draft Order and relevant plan may be inspected at all reasonable hours during 28 days commencing on 2nd August 1993, at the offices of Newcastle-upon-Tyne City Council, Civic Centre, Barras Bridge, Newcastle-upon-Tyne and may be obtained free of charge from the Department of Transport (quoting Ref. DN 5038/35/1/383 at the address stated below.

Any person may object to the making of the proposed Order within the period of 28 days commencing on 2nd August 1993, by notice to the Secretary of State for Transport, quoting the above reference, at the Department of Transport, Northern Regional Office, Wellar House, Gallowgate, Newcastle-upon-Tyne NE1 4TD.

In preparing an objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of it may be imparted to other persons who may be affected by it and that those persons may wish to communicate with the objector about it.
