- (4) Extension of seasonal time restrictions on the use of the parking places in Yewdale Road to include the month of October.

The Borough of Dacorum (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (No. 2) Order 1993

- (e) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (f) the maintenance of the road;
- (g) supply of gas, electricity and water;
- (h) any statutory powers of local authority; and (i) delivery and collection of postal packets.

- 1. Preston Street, between King Street and Western Way, will become one-way in a south-westerly direction.
- 2. The one-way directions will be reversed in:

King Street, between Fore Street and Preston Street, southwesterly direction.

Smythen Street, between Market Street and King Street, southwesterly direction.

which are currently subject to no waiting, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday, or limited waiting restrictions.

8. Waiting will be limited to 30 minutes (no return within 1 hour), 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday, in specified lengths of:

ing Street and Smythen Street

which are currently subject to no waiting at any time or no waiting 9 a.m. to 6 p.m, Monday to Friday, and 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Saturday,

The proposed Order will contain the usual exemptions to the waiting restrictions (7 and 8 above) relating to the picking up and setting down of passengers, loading and unloading of goods, disabled person's vehicles, the maintenance of the road and telecommunications apparatus and the supply of gas, water and electricity.
