LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Leicestershire County Council (High Street (B675) (Part) Barrow-upon-Soar) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 199

Notice is hereby given that the Leicestershire County Council proposes to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to:

- (1) prohibit any vehicle from waiting for more than 40 minutes with return prohibited within 20 minutes, between the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on the side of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice; and
- (2) prohibit any vehicle from waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on the side of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

The Order will contain provisions for exemptions to permit waiting by any disabled person's vehicle and for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, enabling a vehicle to be used in connection with a wedding or funeral and where necessary in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, electricity and water.

Full details are contained in a draft Order which, together with a plan illustrating the proposal, and an explanatory statement giving the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected during normal office hours at my offices, Room 218, County Hall, Glenfield, Leicester, and at the offices of Charnwood Borough Council, Loughborough, Leicestershire.

- (1) to revoke part of Schedule 2 of "The Leicestershire County Council (Prohibition of Commercial Vehicles Over 7.5 Tonnes) (Various Parishes) (Southern Division) Order 1990" insofar as it relates to lengths of roads in the parishes of Whetstone, Cosby and Sutton in the Elms;

- (2) to include those lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this notice into "The Leicestershire County Council (Prohibition of Commercial Vehicles Over 7.5 Tonnes) (Various Parishes) (Southern Division) Order 1990" as Schedule 3; and
- (3) that the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this notice shall be exempt from the roads mentioned in Schedule 1 of the Amendment Order.
