#### *Notice of application for a licence to abstract water*

Take notice that F. B. Parrish & Son of Lodge Farm, Chicksands, Shefford, Bedfordshire SG17 5QB, is applying to the National Rivers Authority for a licence to abstract water from the Lower Greensand at National Grid Reference TL 1169 4040, TL 1176 4026 and TL 1178 4024 at Lodge Farm, in the Parish of Chicksands in the District of Mid-Beds, in the County of Bedfordshire.

The proposal is to abstract water at the following rates: 177.8 cubic metres per hour, 4,270.7 cubic metres per day, 164,280 cubic metres per year, between March and October each year for spray irrigation and; 4 cubic metres per hour, 48 cubic metres per day and 17,520 cubic metres all year for vegetable washing.

The licence is to replace existing licence 6/33/16/116 with no increase in quantities. - (2) From the eastern side of the access lane to the Scout Hall for a distance of approximately 20 metres in a north-easterly direction.

##### *Main Road (south-east side):*

- (1) From a point, opposite and approximately 140 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of Bryn Catwg for a distance of approximately 75 metres in a north-easterly direction.
