Notice is hereby given that the Oldham Borough Council intends to apply to the Magistrates' Court sitting at St. Domingo Place, West Street, Oldham, on Wednesday, 15th September 1993, at 2.15 p.m., for an Order that the unnamed passage approximately 3 metres wide at the rear of numbers 27-31 Calderbrook Way, Oldham, starting at a point approximately 45 metres south-east of the junction of the passage to the side of 40 Retford Street with Retford Street extending in a south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 15 metres be stopped-up on the ground that the highway is unnecessary.
