#### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

*The Trunk Road (A483) (Four Crosses, Welshpool, Powys) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Variation) Order 1993*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under sections 1, 2, 4 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will come into force on 23rd August 1993.

This Order amends the provisions of the Trunk Road (Four Crosses, Welshpool, Powys) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1978 to take account of the changes in the disabled persons' badge (Orange Badge) Scheme, which increased the period of waiting permitted for vehicles displaying such a badge from 2 to 3 hours.

A copy of the proposed Order and the Order which has been varied, together with a plan may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of Montgomeryshire District Council, Severn Road, Welshpool, Powys, during a period of 6 weeks from 21st August 1993.

Copies of the Order may be obtained, free of charge, on application to the Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL, quoting the ref. ZC 510-2-6-45.

If any person desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds:

- (a) that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or
- (b) that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any of the requirements of that Act,

he may, within 6 weeks of the 21st August 1993, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

#### PETROLEUM AND SUBMARINE PIPE-LINES ACT 1975

*Notice of the Issue of a Submarine Pipe-Line Works Authorisation*

The Secretary of State for Trade and Industry hereby gives notice that he has decided to issue, and in consequence has issued, a works authorisation to be held by Shell U.K. Limited, whose address is Shell Mex House, Strand, London WC2R 0DX, for the construction of a 10 inch pipe-line and an 8 inch pipe-line at Breat Alpha Platform.

Except with the consent of the Secretary of State, the 10 inch pipe-line shall only be used to convey crude oil and hydrocarbon gas and the 8 inch pipe-line only be used to convey water, scale inhibitor and corrosion inhibitor.

The pipe-lines may be used by the holder and with the holder's agreement, and with the consent of the Secretary of State, by other persons.

Shell U.K. Limited has been appointed operator of the pipe-lines.
