(b) that the routes along which the gas will require to be conveyed will severally be, as to the whole or any part thereof, the same or substantially the same as the route or any part of the route so

- (a) an indication in respect of the gas for the conveyance of which a demand may exist or be likely to arise, of
 - (i) its origin;
 - (ii) its quantity; and
 - (iii) the rate at which it may be conveyed,

is delivered within 28 days of publication of this notice; and
