Proposed Stopping-Up of a Highway at Rochdale

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that, on application of Cooper & Jackson, on behalf of Drayton Motors (Rochdale) Ltd., he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act, which will authorise the stopping-up of Vincent Street, Rochdale.

If the Order is made, the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted to Drayton Motors by Rochdale Metropolitan Borough Council on 22nd April 1993 under Ref. D29031.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The proposed Order would revoke "The Conversion of Highways into Footpaths or Bridleways (London Borough of Barking and Dagenham) (No. 1) Order 1980" in so far as it relates to a length of East Street, Barking. The effect of the Order would be to reinstate any right to use vehicles on that length of East Street, Barking from its junction with Ripple Road south-westwards for a distance of 59 metres.
