  - (a) Hartlands Road, on the west and south-west side from its junction with West Street to its junction with Western Road but excluding the lay-bys which extend:
  - (i) from a point 50 metres south-east of its junction with West Street south-eastwards for a distance of 25 metres.
  - (ii) from a point 78 metres south-east of its junction with West Street south-eastwards for a distance of 22 metres.
  - (b) Hartlands Road, on the east and north-east side from its junction with West Street to a point opposite the north side of Western Road.
  - (c) Portland Street, on both sides from its junction with Hartlands Road eastwards then southwards to its junction with Quay Street Roundabout.
- 3. To Prohibit Waiting at Any Time (including for the purpose of Loading and Unloading between 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m.) in the following length of road:

Westbury Road, on both sides from its junction with West Street northwards for a distance of 85 metres.

4. To Prohibit at Any Time (including for the purpose of Loading and Unloading) in the following length of road:

Portland Street, on both sides from its junction with West Street southwards for a distance of 114 metres.

- 5. To Prohibit Waiting on Monday to Saturday between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. inclusive, in the following lengths of road:
  - (a) Hartlands Road, on the south-western side from its junction with the south side of Western Road to its southern end.
