ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Essex County Council (Threadneedle Street, Chelmsford)
(Prohibition of Driving) Order 1993*

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the Order: To prohibit the driving of vehicles in Threadneedle Street, Chelmsford. Threadneedle Street will also cease to be subject to one-way working north to south.

Exemptions in the Order will permit access from Duke Street to the northernmost 45 metres of Threadneedle Street for loading and unloading and for disabled drivers going to and from the disabled persons car park to the rear of the toilets in Market Road.

In respect of that length of Threadneedle Street extending from a point 45 metres south of Duke Street to Market Road, access will only be permitted by permit issued by the Council.

Further Details: A copy of the draft Order together with a map illustrating the proposal, a statement of reasons and a copy of the Borough of Chelmsford (Various Streets) (Consolidation of One-way Traffic) Order 1974 which contains provisions being revoked may be examined at all reasonable hours at the Local Government Library, County Hall (E Block), Chelmsford.

Objections: Anyone who wishes to object to the proposal should send the grounds for their objection in writing to the undersigned by 17th September 1993.

NB. The proposals supersede those previously advertised in November 1992 as the Borough of Chelmsford (Threadneedle Street, Chelmsford) (Prohibition of Entry) Order 199 .

*The County of Gwynedd (Unclassified Road in Talsarnau)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1993*

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Gwynedd proposes to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to 2(3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit vehicles from waiting at any time on the side of length of road specified in the Schedule hereto.

Exceptions will permit waiting:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading or unloading goods;

and where necessary in connection with:

- (c) certain building operations;
- (d) the maintenance of the road;
- (e) the supply of gas, electricity, water or other statutory undertakings;
- (f) the exercise of local authority powers and functions;
- (g) the exercise of postal functions;
- (h) fire brigade, ambulance and police purposes;
- (i) and in certain circumstances when the vehicle is a disabled person's vehicle.

The draft Order, together with a map showing the lengths of roads concerned, and a statement of the council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at:

- (a) County Offices, Caernarfon, and
- (b) The Post Office, Talsarnau,

during normal business hours.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order, you should send your objection in writing specifying the grounds thereof to the undersigned at the address specified by 20th September 1993.
