ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The A55 Trunk Road (Bodelwyddan, Clwyd) (One-way Traffic) Order 199

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Following the construction of the St. Asaph Business Park Interchange, the lay-by on which one-way driving was imposed by means of the Trunk Road (A55) (Bodelwyddan, Clwyd) (One-way Traffic) Order 1986, no longer exists and part of the access road similarly affected by that Order is now considered suitable for two-way traffic. The effect of the proposed Order will be to revoke and re-enact, amended as necessary, the provisions of the existing Order to reflect this development and to prohibit traffic from proceeding in any direction other than from south to north in the length of remaining access road described in the Schedule to this notice.

A copy of the proposed Order and the Order being revoked, together with a plan and a statement of reasons for the making of

the Order, may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of Rhuddlan Borough Council, Russell House, Churton Road, Rhyl Clwyd.

Objections, specifying the grounds on which they are made and quoting reference ZC510-2-1-65 must be sent in writing to the Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Roads Administration Division, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL, by 3rd November 1993. In the preparation of an objection and statement of grounds of objection, it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.
