

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The A565 Trunk Road (Formby Bypass, Formby) (Prohibition of Use of Gaps in Central Reservation) (No. 2) Order 1993

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport proposes to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A565 Trunk Road (Formby Bypass, Formby) between its roundabout junction with Liverpool Road (B5424) at Alt Bridge to the south of Formby, and its junction with Liverpool Old Road at the northern end of the bypass.

The effect of the Order will be to close 10 gaps (specified in the Schedule to this notice) in the central reservation of the A565 Trunk Road Formby Bypass, at Formby, in the Metropolitan Borough of Sefton.

Pedestrian use will be maintained opposite the junction with Mitten's Lane (gap No. 2). Pedestrian/Equestrian use will be maintained opposite the junction with Eight Acre Lane (gap No. 4).

SCHEDULE

Prohibition of Use of Gaps in Central Reservation of the A565 Trunk Road Formby Bypass, at Formby in the Metropolitan Borough of Sefton.

The gaps in the central reservation of the trunk road:

1. 350 metres south of the junction with Altcar Road (B5195),
 2. Opposite the junction with Mitten's Lane, [Pedestrian use to be maintained]
 3. 180 metres north of the junction with Southport Road (B5424),
 4. Opposite the junction with Eight Acre Lane, [Pedestrian/Equestrian use to be maintained]
 5. 207 metres north of the junction with Eight Acre Lane,
 6. 403 metres north of the junction with Eight Acre Lane.
 7. 594 metres south of the junction with Liverpool Old Road,
 8. 414 metres south of the junction with Liverpool Old Road,
 9. 150 metres south of the junction with Liverpool Old Road, and
 10. 127 metres south of the junction with Liverpool Old Road.
