NATIONAL RIVERS AUTHORITY

Notice of application for a licence to abstract water

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

AVON COUNTY COUNCIL

Avon County Council (Portishead Area, District of Woodspring) (General Traffic Regulation) (Consolidation) Order 199

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Avon proposes to make an Order under sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be:

- (1) to prohibit any vehicle waiting at any time, subject to specified exemptions, in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;
- (2) to restrict any vehicle, subject to specified exemptions, waiting in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice for a longer period than 30 minutes in any one hour between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day;
- (3) to consolidate the County Council of Avon (Victoria Square (Eastern Arm), Portishead, District of Woodspring) (Prohibition of Entry) Order 1978 and the County Council of Avon (Portishead Area, District of Woodspring) (General Traffic Regulation) Order 1984, the provisions of which will be included in this proposed Order without amendment, with the exception of those items included in (1) and (2) above.

Full details of the proposal are contained in the draft Order, which together with a map, a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order and copies of the Orders to be revoked, may be inspected at the undermentioned offices (callers should report to Reception and ask for the Statutory Orders Section) during normal office hours and at Portishead Public Library, The High Street, Portishead BS20 9EW, during normal opening hours.

Objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the County Solicitor and Deputy Clerk at the undermentioned address quoting ref. LET/P-6-020 by 31st December 1993. Please note that all representations received may be considered in public by the County Council and that the substance of any representation, together with the name and address of the person making it could become available for public inspection.

Albert Road:

- north side, from High Street to 10 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Brampton Way;
- south side, from High Street for 10 metres.

Avon Way:

- south-east side:
 - (a) from 10 metres north-east of Gordano View to 10 metres south-west of Gordano View;
 - (b) from 10 metres north-east of Link Road to 10 metres south-west of Link Road.

Bristol Road:

- north-east side, from 74 metres south-east of High Street south-east and eastwards for 100 metres;
- south side, from 112 metres west of Cadbury Road westwards for 35 metres;
