The Stopping-up of Highways (County of Essex) (No. 23) Order 1993

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that, on the application of H. G. Kendall White, he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-up of Highways (County of Essex) (No. 23) Order 1993" authorising the stopping-up of highway land in Mill End, Thaxted, Essex, to enable development consisting of the proposed extension and restoration of dwelling house to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to H. G. Kendall White by Uttlesford District Council on 28th March 1991 under ref. UTT/0117/91.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 6th January 1994 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

The M20 Motorway (M26 to A228 Castle Way Side Roads) Order 199

The M20 Motorway (A228 Castle Way to A20 Coldharbour Lane Side Roads) Order 199

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make two Orders under sections 12, 18 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980, in relation to the parts of the M20 Motorway situated between the M26 Motorway and the A228 Castle Way and

between the A228 Castle Way and the A20 Coldharbour Lane in the County of Kent, which will:

- (1) authorise him to:
 - (a) improve highways,
 - (b) stop up highways,
 - (c) construct new highways,
 - (d) stop up means of access to premises,(e) provide new means of access to premises,

all in the vicinity of the M20 Motorway mentioned above; and (2) provide for the transfer of each new highway to the Kent County Council as highway authority as from the date on which he notifies them that it has been completed and is open for
