ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The A55 and A494 Trunk Roads (Ewloe, Clwyd) (Prohibition of Cyclists) Order 199

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to prohibit cyclists from proceeding in those lengths of the A55 and A494 Trunk Roads, and connecting slip and link roads, described in the Schedule to this notice. The alternative routes, which will include the existing road network and a new cycle track between Mold Road and the A494, will be fully signed.

SCHEDULE

The A55 Chester-Bangor Trunk Road and the A494 South of Birkenhead-Dolgellau Trunk Road are referred to respectively as "the first trunk road" and "the second trunk road":

1. That length of the north-westbound carriageway of the first trunk road which extends from a point 320 metres south-east of the centrepiece of Dobshill Interchange to the centrepiece of its junction with Pinfold Lane.
