 (c) all the pigs to be consigned for slaughter have been identified with an eartag or tattoo prior to sampling;

 (d) all animals in the holding of origin are subjected to a clinical examination by an authorised veterinarian within 24 hours prior to consignment;

(e) the holding of origin does not contain any pigs that have originated in the area listed in Annex I of Commission Decision 93/602/EEC in the previous 60 days;

(f) the pigs must be accompanied to slaughter by a health document (Guia Sanitaria de Transito de Suinos) from an official veterinarian stating that the above points have been complied with.

D. All consignments of products to which this licence refers are subject to the terms of the Products of Animal Origin (Import and Export) Regulations 1992, and any product imported under this licence shall be made available, if so required, for inspection by an officer of the Ministry at a place nominated by him/her for such inspection, and in particular the provisions of Regulation 7(3) of the above Regulations shall apply. before heating each piece of meat as referred to above was enclosed in a hermetically sealed container to be marketed therein.

the meat in its container underwent heat treatment in strict conformity with the following conditions,

(a) the product was kept at a temperature of at least 60°C for a minimum of four hours during which the centre temperature must be at least 70°C for a minimum of 30 minutes,

(b) the temperature of a representative number of samples of each batch of products was monitored constantly. Monitoring was carried out using automatic apparatus enabling the temperature to be recorded both in the centre of the pieces of meat product and inside the heating equipment.
