TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping-up of lengths of Beechwood Avenue and Hearsall Common, Coventry.

If the Order is made, the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted to Arlington Property and Austin Rover Group Ltd. by Coventry City Council on 23rd December 1992 under reference No. B/44300.

The proposed Order will require an improvement of Hearsall Common by widening and the provision of new footpaths maintainable at the public expense for which the City Council will be the local Highway Authority.

Copies of the draft Order and relevant plan may be inspected at all reasonable hours during 28 days commencing on 8th March 1994 at the offices of Coventry City Council, The Council House, Earl Street, Coventry and may be obtained free of charge from the Department of Transport (quoting ref. Any person may object to the making of the proposed Order within the period of 28 days commencing on 8th March 1994, by notice to the Secretary of State for Transport, quoting the above reference, at the Department of Transport West Midlands Regional Office, No. 5 Broadway, Broad Street, Birmingham B15 1BL.

In preparing an objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of it may be imparted to other persons who may be affected by it and that those persons may wish to communicate with the objector about it.
