WOLVERHAMPTON BOROUGH COUNCIL

Notice is hereby given that on 8th March 1994 and further to the notice published in *The London Gazette* under issue no. 53579 and reference no. 778 the Wolverhampton Borough Council made the following Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("The Act"). The effect of the Orders, which come into operation on 16th March 1994, is as follows:

1. *The Borough of Wolverhampton (Street Parking Places, Bilston) (No. 1 Order) 1993*

This Order, made under sections 32 and 35 of the Act will designate 35 parking bays in Greencroft for use by disabled persons' vehicles only.

2. *The Borough of Wolverhampton (Broad Street, Bilston) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1993*

This Order, made under sections 1, 2, 4 and 124(d) of the Act will prohibit waiting and loading at any time in part of Broad Street at its junction with High Street/Church Street.

3. *The Borough of Wolverhampton (Walsall Street, Bilston) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1993*

This Order, made under sections 1, 2 4 and 124(d) of the Act will prohibit waiting and loading at any time in part of Walsall Street.

Copies of the Orders and plans showing the roads affected may be inspected during normal office hours at the Civic Centre, St. Peter's Square, Wolverhampton.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Orders, or of any provision contained in the Orders, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act, or on the ground that any requirement of those sections or of Parts I to III to Schedule

9 to the Act or any regulation made under the said Part III has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks of 8th March 1994, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACTS

MALVERN HILLS DISTRICT COUNCIL

PLANNING (LISTED BUILDINGS AND CONSERVATION AREAS) ACT 1990

Notice is hereby given that in accordance with section 69(1) of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990, the Malvern Hills District Council designated on 2nd February 1994, the undermentioned area of Whitbourne as a Conservation Area:

Whitbourne, that part of the village to include Whitbourne Court, St. John the Baptist Church, The Olde Rectory, The Kennetts, The Nutshell, Little Nut, Kennetts Cottage, The Brook Cottage, Virginia Cottage, Ring O'Bells and land to the south of these properties embraced by Whitbourne Brook.

The effect of the designation of this Conservation Area will be that no person may, without the written consent of the Council, demolish any building or cut down, top, lop, uproot or wilfully damage any tree within the Conservation Area. Offences against these provisions may result in heavy fines.

The Council will also give special attention to the desirability of preserving or enhancing the character or appearance of the area.
