Notice of application for a licence to obstruct or impede the flow of an inland water by means of impounding works

Take notice that Wyn Harries Davies of Blaenmaenog, Felindre, Llandysul, Dyfed, is applying to the National Rivers Authority for a licence to obstruct or impede the flow of a small watercourse on the south side of O.S. No. 390, at National Grid Ref. 36063541 at Blaenmaenog in the Parish of Felindre. Water will be impounded by a water retaining embankment and the object of the impounding works is the creation of a pool for conservation and amenity. Take notice that Allan R. Fairfax & Julie Catherine Evans of Coedymwstwr Isaf Farm, Coychurch, Bridgend, are applying to the National Rivers Authority for a licence to abstract water from borehole, at at National Grid Ref. 55 9455 8035 at Coychurch, Lower, Ogwr District. The proposal is to abstract water at the following rates: 13.59 cubic metres per hour, 59 cubic metres per day, 11,235 cubic metres per year, between 1st January and 31st December each year. The water will be used for irrigation of tees and greens and water supply to clubhouse and supply two pools.
