##### SCHEDULE 2

##### *Prohibition of Driving Order*

- High Street/Orchard Street Link Road:* To prohibit all vehicles from being driven along the High Street/Orchard Street Link Road, between its junction with High Street and a point approximately 5 metres west of that junction.
- To prohibit all vehicles from being driven along Princess Way in either direction between its junction with Kingsway Roundabout and Caer Street, a distance of approximately 175 metres.
