ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The A6 Trunk Road (Desborough Road, Rothwell, Northamptonshire) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 19

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be that no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h. on that length of the A6 Trunk Road known as Desborough Road in the Town of Rothwell in the Borough of Kettering in the county

of Northamptonshire, from a point 250 metres north of its junction with Greening Road for a distance of 500 metres in a southerly direction.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a plan illustrating the proposal and a statement explaining the Secretary of State's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected during office hours at the offices of the Director of Network Management and Construction, Highways Agency, Cranbrook House, Cranbrook Street, Nottingham; of the Chief Executive, Kettering Borough Council, Municipal Offices, Bowling Green Road, Kettering, Northamptonshire; and to the Rothwell Library, Market Hill, Rothwell, Northamptonshire.
