STOCKTON-ON-TEES BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Stockton-on-Tees (Off-Street Parking Places, Stockton) (Amendment) (No. 10) Order 1994

Notice is hereby given that the Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 32, 35(1), (3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order will have the effect of:

- Changing the Hume Street Car Park from a long stay car park to a short stay car park with the following scale of charges for its use:
 - £0-10p for up to 2 hours,
 - £1.00 for up to 3 hours, and £0-50p for each hour or part thereof in excess of 3 hours.
- Prohibiting vehicles which have been parked in a short stay car park from returning to any short stay car park within 2 hours.
