Notice is hereby given that Blackpool Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, with the Lancashire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the said Act of 1984, propose to make the above Order.

The effect of the Order will be to:

- (1) Implement a Peak Hour Clearway Order, between the hours of 4 p.m. to midnight on Saturdays and Sundays during the Illuminations period, which will prohibit all traffic (except buses operating a local service setting down or picking up passengers and certain other exempted vehicles) from stopping on both sides of the Promenade from its junction with Burlington Road West, to its junction with Lytham Road (Manchester Square).
